The ultra-secure Hoox system

Hoox is a secure smartphone designed by Bull and is the first professional native-security smartphone. The material layers, operating system and software were designed to provide a high level of security. Hoox encrypts voice and SMS data and all data stored or exchanged, and protects the applications. The terminal is protected against malware, with anti-intrusion systems operating in the communication ports.



Hoox is a mobility solution certified by the French IT Systems Security Agency ANSSI for the Restricted Distribution communication level.



It was awarded the France Cybersecurity Label in January 2015, and was appraised in a Gartner report, "Critical Capabilities for High-Security Mobility 2015".
